NOTES ON SELECTED PATTERNS

Knotted Sevens page 8

Knotted Sevens is a seven-pointed star in the form of a knot. This pattern is a representation of the magical number seven. Based on a pattern from a Hebrew manuscript dated 1472.

Santa Clara's Petals and Santa Clara's Arcade page 9, 10

A pair of patterns in the Gothic style, inspired by a Franciscan choir book dated 1476 – 1500.

Spanish Cypress page 12

The Spanish Cypress pattern is an investigation of the theme of the garden, an important motif in Muslim design. The design shows a row of cypress trees set against an architectural arcade, stars above and below linking the heavens to the earth.

Pyxis page 27

Pyxis is Latin meaning box, in this case a small, decorated container. This henna design pattern has been adapted from one bearing the following inscription:

The sight that I offer is the fairest of sights, the still firm breasts of lovely young woman. Beauty has bestowed upon me a robe clad with jewels, so that I am a vessel for musk and camphor and ambergris; made by khalaf.

It's Knot my Fault! Page 33

This knot is a representation of a formal Islamic garden. It shows four pools situated around a central courtyard. Arcades lead away from the centre where palm trees are framed in

- the architectural arches to create a pleasing view along each path.

Pamplona page 41

A pattern in the Romanesque style from the cloister of the Pamplona Cathedral, c. 1140.

Albarello page 47, 48

An Albarello is a tall thin jar produced for use in a pharmacy. Highly decorated and very beautiful, these were made and decorated by Moorish potters. This pattern features a bold design with detail contained within the main motif, one of a number in this book drawn using the same technique.

Floral Scroll page 52

The Floral scroll is based on a motif from a Hebrew bible showing the cross-cultural influences typical of medieval Spain. Although Jewish in origin, this pattern uses shapes that are typically Moorish, c. 1300.

Corrida de Toros page 53


Fierce and brave. A pattern to call to mind the passions of the bullfight.

Bryony Flowers page 54


A very small simple flower typical of medieval Spanish ceramic decoration. The Bryony flower translates very easily to work with henna and is used throughout this book.









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


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



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





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
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



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


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





















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









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




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
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






























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






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


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


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


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
